This routine must include one, two and three baton and showcase the best of a twirlers abilities.</p> <p>**Routines should include multiple body spins (2 or more, rolls, finger twirls, high toss tricks of the twirlers choice and multiple baton work.</p> <p>During Auditions: In addition each twirlers <u>individual routine</u>, potential twirlers will be taught a basic routine at auditions that will be performed as a means of evaluating one's ability to memorize and perform a routine as well as one's response to new and potentially challenging situations.</p> <p>*Twirlers may also be asked to perform high toss tricks of their choosing in isolation.</p>	<p>Those able to attend live auditions will have <u>priority consideration</u> for the AB scholarship.</p> <p>AB Scholarship = 1, 000 a year each year for <u>four year</u> participation</p>
